






Create a project




The registration of a new project is completed by the 2 project founders. After the approval of the project more project partners can de added.





When you want to create a new project one of the 2 founders needs to submit the key elements of the project.


The application process consists of 4 steps.







Step 1



The first step is to select your school. You can select only one school, even if you have more than one in your list. This choice can't be changed afterwards.



Step 2



In step 3 you need to give the key elements of the project. These elements can be modified after the project has been approved but it is advisable to fill in the elements as completely as possible from the very start.







If you want to collaborate with partners from eTwinning Plus countries, you must indicate this in the settings of your profile (MY INTERESTS). Only if you express that you are available for an eTwinning Plus project you will be able to view and add contacts from eTwinning Plus countries. eTwinning Plus teachers will only be able to see your profile if you indicate your availability.

Apart from the Project Title and a Short Description for the project you have to also tick the working Language(s) used in the project, select the Age Range of the Pupils, the Subjects in which the project will take place as well as the Tools that will be used.



AIMS

Try to be specific, particularly in terms of competences and skills you hope your pupils will gain through this project. Refrain from stating too abstract concepts such as "European Dimension of education" or "Intercultural communication".

A description of the Aims, the Work Process and the Expected Results is also needed.

WORK PROCESS

State how you intend to work with your partner schools and how responsibilities are shared. Give an approximate calendar of activities, state how frequently you will work with your partner; indicate how you intend to involve your pupils; if you intend to create teams of pupils of different schools, and other relevant information.

EXPECTED RESULTS

Indicate here if you are planning a final product such a public Twinspace or other resources. You might envisage instead the improvement of a school practice, or new knowledge.

From then the project will have a PENDING status until it is reviewed by the National Support Services.

When the project is approved it will become active and the Project Founders will have access to the project Twinspace.
